

GREEN CHARTER ON SPANISH SPORT (SUMMARY)

1 BINDING CHARACTER OF 'GREEN CHARTER ON SPANISH SPORT'

The signatory entities and organizations assume generic commitments in environmental protection and **Sustainable Development**.

For the elaboration of this 'Green Charter on Spanish Sport' the following milestones, among others, have been considered:

- The conclusions of Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro in 1992.
- Earth Charter Initiative.
- Olympics Movement Agenda 21 from International Olympic Committee (IOC).
- Spanish Strategy on Sport and Sustainable Development (2007).

2 BASIC RECTORS PRINCIPLES

Sport, like community, can exert a very important role in the spread and the awareness of **Sustainable Development's values** that, in short, it does not imply the conditioning of the freedom of future generations' actions avoiding the environmental degradation and the social imbalances.

Special attention will be paid to:

- Water save and efficient use.
- Minimize the energy use, developing renewable energy.
- Wastes' reduction, support to recycling and reutilization.
- Restore the affected areas.
- Preservation of the archaeological, historical and cultural patrimony.
- Fight against the violence in the sport manifestations.
- Promote the inclusion and cohesion of all the social sectors.

GREEN CHARTER ON SPANISH SPORT (SUMMARY)

3 COMMITMENT ELEMENTS OF 'GREEN CHARTER ON SPANISH SPORT'

A) Institutional integration of the principles of Sustainable Development

- To integrate in the statutes, regulations and own norms, the principles of Sustainable Development.
- To promote in the entity some structure as regards Sustainable Development (committee, department or designate responsible people).
- Commitment of helping the development of the Agenda 21 on Spanish Sport.

B) Installation of approaches for environmental integrity and social cohesion

- To begin and to be on the side of the environmental administration's entity.
- To promote the performances of cultural and social integration.
- Search of fair play: against drug taking, violence and xenophobia.

C) Participation, promotion and spread processes on Sustainable Development

- To diffuse the content of the Green Charter.
- To promote progressively the training and internal environmental understanding.
- To promote projects and campaigns of awareness, communication and external spread.

D) Collaboration with other related targets

- Maximum collaboration with the public administrations.
- To promote actions in collaboration with social organizations.
- To promote the implication of private companies in sustainable management

4 APPLICATIONS AND PURSUIT OF THE GREEN CHARTER

The Green Charter will be able to be revised in order to improve its contents, creating for this pursuit 'Observatory of the Green Charter on Spanish Sport', which will be coordinated by Spanish Sport Agency.
